INCA TRAIL



Known as Qhapaq Ñan (the sovereign's highway). The Inca Trail is one of the most famous and beautiful treks in the world. It follows the stone road which the Incas used to access Machu Picchu from their capital, Cusco. The 38-kilometre (27-mile) trail is remarkable for its wonderful scenery, the diversity of the landscape and the ruins that you pass through.

SALKANTAY



Salkantay Trek, named among the 25 best Treks in the World, by National Geographic connects the city of Mollepata, Cusco with Machu Picchu. It is an ancient and remote footpath located in the same region as the Inca Trail where massive snowcapped mountains collide with lush tropical rain forests.

AUSANGATE

An amazing and less-known trek surrounding the snow-capped Sacred Mountain ("Apu") of Ausangate (6.372m/20900ft) that takes you over mountain passes, awesome mountain scenery, remote Andean villages, hot springs and turquoise lakes.

LARES

This is a very cultural trek - in the Lares region the red of the typical ponchos and skirts stand out from a distance as children herd flocks of sheep and llamas. Stone houses are covered with thatched roofs and its like you have stepped back into the middle ages, while great herds of Llamas roam the landscape as you hike. The traditional Lares Valley treks are blessed with plenty of high mountain scenery.
