About Peru



It is an extremely diverse country, with 11 ecological regions and 84 of the world's 117 different types of "life zone". It is the third largest country in South America and one of the 20 largest countries in the world.

By air: Regular flights to the major world cities from the Jorge Chavez International Airport (located in the Callao Region, approximately 30 minute from Lima).


