



2 day / 1 night program Llachon Community & Taquile Island

Day 01 – Llachon Community

Today we will head to the western shores of Lake Titicaca to visit the Village of Llachon located on the Capachica Peninsula, a place where time has stopped, where you will appreciate the customs and experiences of a local community.

Upon arrival to Llachon Village, we will be received by our local host and be accommodated at the assigned family home.

After having lunch with the host family, in the afternoon share the fishing techniques on Lake Titicaca by small rowing boats, or walk to the summit of the nearby hill from where the majestic Lake Titicaca may be admired, admire the beautiful agricultural terraces on the slopes and visit a pre-Inca temple where you will be able to make your wishes by leaving coca leaves.

For dinner, we will be accompanied by some of the community members in a mystical setting surrounded by remains from the Pucara-Tiahuanaco culture, which still remains a sacred place for them and where they practice their most important religious and cultural ritual: Pachamama, the ceremony of offering in honor to Mother Earth

Overnight stay at Llachon Island's communal housing.

Day 02 – Taquile

AM: Excursion to Taquile Island (private)

Early today, you will enjoy a motorboat trip to Taquile Island, inhabited by Quechua-speaking natives who have developed efficient and unique social systems, as well as fine hand weaving techniques, passed down through the generations.

Upon arrival at the Town of Taquile we will have a lunch at one of the local homes served by

the owners, designated by the local authorities as they are a very well organized town so all their inhabitants may have equal opportunities with their visitors.

After lunch, take a walk through the various hills and archaeological sites of this 6 km long Island.

Return to your hotel in Puno after the visit.
