



Full day excursion to the Uros Islands, Luquina Community & Chucuito Village incl. lunch (private)

Early in the morning, you will have an unforgettable motorboat excursion on the waters of Lake Titicaca to the unique "Floating Islands" of the Uros.

These ancient inhabitants of the lake known as the Water Tribe have built their own islands by periodically adding new layers of a vegetable fiber of the Papyrus family called "Totorá" (scientific *Scirpus totora*), which is unique to the area.

We continue our motorboat trip to the peninsula of Chucuito for a stop at the rural Aymara Community of Luquina, where you will savor a buffet lunch including regional dishes while enjoying a magnificent view of Lake Titicaca.

Return to Puno by land and end your day with a visit to Chucuito Village, one of the oldest towns in the area surrounded by farming fields that slope gently down to Lake Titicaca. This town was once the capital of the whole province and has colonial churches on its two main squares: Nuestra Señora de la Asunción Temple, sitting near the upper Plaza de Armas with its Renaissance facade from 1601 and, Santo Domingo Temple, with its L-shape and beautifully painted stone arches, a wooden altar carved in gold leaf and a single ancient stone tower.

After the tour you will be transferred to your hotel.
